

Batch Testing & Release Protocol

Water, RO & Sanitation

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a batch-testing and release protocol — what to test per batch, limits, documentation and hold-and-release rules — so no non-conforming water reaches the market. Use it to govern batch release.

Purpose of this tool & output

Test and release each batch properly

How the output is used

Use it to test and release each batch properly — a batch testing and release protocol that stops out-of-spec water shipping.

Important cautions

Microbiological results take time and releasing before results carries risk; a clear positive-release and recall-ready policy is essential. Align batch and release rules with BIS and FSSAI and your quality standard.
