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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a distribution plan for packaged water — delivery model, routing, distributor versus own-fleet, coverage and cost — to serve customers reliably and cheaply. Use it to design distribution for jar and bottle water.

Purpose of this tool & output

Plan jar and bottle distribution

How the output is used

Use it to plan jar and bottle distribution — a water distribution and delivery plan across routes, reach and returns.

Important cautions

Delivery cost and reliability make or break jar-water economics and depend on density and routing; distributor margins must still leave you profit. Validate route economics and jar reconciliation before scaling coverage.
