This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a distributor or dealer agreement for packaged water — territory, targets, pricing, margins, jar handling, standards and credit — between a producer and a distributor. Use it to formalise a distribution arrangement.

Purpose of this tool & output

Appoint a water distributor or dealer

How the output is used

Use the draft to appoint a water distributor or dealer — territory, margin, targets, credit and branding with discrete terms — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the water business and the distributor/dealer; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act where applicable; the territory, margin and credit terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the territory, margin, credit and termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

A draft template, not legal advice; jar-reconciliation, credit and brand-and-hygiene standards need care and product tampering carries safety and legal risk. Have a lawyer review and confirm stamping before signing.
