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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Assesses whether a specific water or sanitation venture is viable — source and quality, demand, economics, regulation and risks — with a go or no-go. Use it before investing in a plant or fleet.

Purpose of this tool & output

Test if a water venture is viable

How the output is used

Use it to test if a water venture is viable — the demand, source, cost-per-litre and margin economics before you commit.

Who should vet it

An experienced water-plant operator and a CA, to sanity-check the demand, cost-per-litre and margin before you invest.

Important cautions

A desk feasibility view from your inputs; water-source yield and quality need testing and the market is competitive. Commission source and water-quality testing and confirm groundwater and other clearances before investing.
