

Quality Control SOP

Water, RO & Sanitation

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a quality-control SOP for a water plant — source, in-process and finished testing, parameters and limits, sampling, non-conformance and records — so every batch is safe and compliant. Use it to run QC to BIS and FSSAI standards.

Use it to control quality across every batch — a quality control SOP across source, in-process and finished-product testing.

Important cautions

Parameters, limits and testing must follow the applicable standard and accredited methods and be adapted to your source; microbiological safety is critical. Confirm limits and methods with BIS and an accredited lab.
