Sourcing & Procurement

Fabric Sourcing Guide

Source the right fabric at the right price — a sourcing plan (specs, hubs, MOQ, lead time), selection criteria (GSM, composition, colourfastness, shrinkage, hand feel), commercials and the questions to ask suppliers. Fill in your details below.

Yarn Procurement Planner

Plan yarn buying for a mill or knitter — a procurement plan (count and type, sourcing, MOQ, lead time, price-trend awareness), the quality parameters to check (count, CV, strength, evenness) and a buying strategy (spot vs contract). Fill in your details below.

Supplier Evaluation Framework

Choose reliable suppliers objectively — weighted evaluation criteria (quality, price, lead time, capacity, compliance, reliability), a supplier-versus-criteria comparison template and a factory and social compliance note. Fill in your details below.

Fabric / Material Purchase Contract

Get a fabric or material purchase contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering material and specs, quantity and schedule, price and escalation, quality and testing, shortages and shade variation, payment, GST, penalties and dispute resolution, plus schedules. Trims & Accessories Sourcing

Source your trims and accessories — a trims list with spec, sourcing, MOQ and lead time, the quality checks (function, colourfastness, export compliance) and consolidation tips. Fill in your details below.

Plan fabric and trims from your order quantity — a material plan by item (fabric, trims, packing) with consumption per unit, gross requirement, wastage and total with buffer, plus order-by dates from lead time. Fill in your details below.

Onboard suppliers with the right checks — onboarding steps (application, documents, samples, compliance check, agreement, master creation), the documents to collect and the compliance check for export vendors. Fill in your details below.

Get a controlled sourcing and purchase SOP — the process (requirement, RFQ, sampling, approval, PO, follow-up, inspection, payment), an approval matrix and controls (sample approval, price comparison, vendor master). Fill in your details below.

Garment Production Plan

Plan production to hit shipment dates — a style-wise plan (quantity, line, daily target, start and end), a capacity check (load vs available) and the likely bottlenecks. Fill in your details below.

Optimise fabric use in cutting — a cutting plan (marker planning, ratio, lay planning, ply, spreading), efficiency (marker efficiency target, wastage control) and quality (cutting accuracy, bundling, numbering). Fill in your details below.

Balance a sewing line to lift output — takt time and target output, an operation-by-operation allocation (SAM, operators, workload), line efficiency, bottleneck operations and recommendations. Fill in your details below.

Production Floor SOP

Standardise the production floor — SOPs per process (cutting, sewing, finishing, packing) with steps and quality checks, plus flow control (bundle system, WIP, hourly output). Fill in your details below.

WIP Tracking System

Control work in progress across the floor — a WIP tracking method (bundle tracking, process-wise WIP, hourly board), controls (WIP limits, flow balancing, bottleneck focus) and cut-to-ship reconciliation records. Fill in your details below.

Machine Maintenance Schedule

Keep your machines running — a maintenance schedule per machine with checks and frequency (daily, weekly, monthly), the common spares to stock and a maintenance log. Fill in your details below.

Production Audit

Find losses in production and quality — checks and gaps by area (line balancing, efficiency, quality and rework, WIP, housekeeping), a rating scorecard and priority fixes. Fill in your details below.

Quality Control

Quality Control SOP

Get an end-to-end quality control SOP — QC stages (incoming fabric, cutting, inline sewing, finishing, final) with checks and AQL criteria, defect handling (rework, reject, root cause) and inspection records. Fill in your details below.

AQL Inspection Guide

Run buyer-standard AQL inspections — the basics (sampling by lot size and AQL level, accept and reject numbers), the inspection process (random sampling, defect classification, decision) and documentation. Fill in your details below.

Fabric Inspection (4-Point) Guide

Grade incoming fabric objectively with the 4-point system — point allocation by defect size, points per 100 sq metres and acceptance, the inspection process (sampling, defect marking, shade and width, shrinkage) and acceptance criteria. Fill in your details below.

Catch sewing defects early — an inline inspection plan (check points, frequency, operation-wise focus), a defect-feedback loop for immediate correction, and inline records with defect trends. Fill in your details below.

Test for the parameters buyers demand — a test plan (colourfastness, shrinkage, fibre composition, pH, pilling, strength, banned substances) with the standard and when to test, buyer and regulatory awareness (REACH, CPSIA) and accredited labs. Fill in your details below.

Quality Manual Builder

Document your quality system — a quality manual with policy, organisation and roles, processes (incoming, inline, final, testing), standards (AQL, buyer specs) and records. Useful for buyer audits. Fill in your details below.

Fix quality failures at the root — an NCR with CAPA covering the problem, containment, root cause, corrective and preventive actions and verification. Fill in your details below.

Tech Pack Builder

Get a complete tech pack structure — style summary, fabric and trims, measurements (POM list with tolerances), construction details (stitch, seam, SPI), artwork and labels, and packing. Fill in your details below.

Design Brief Writer

Brief designers clearly — a design brief with season and theme, target customer, mood and palette, silhouettes and categories, fabric direction and price positioning. Fill in your details below.

Sampling Plan & Tracker

Manage samples from proto to PP — the sampling stages (proto, fit, size set, salesman, PP, TOP), the tracker fields to maintain and the approval gates (PP approval before bulk). Fill in your details below.

Measurement Spec Sheet

Get a measurement spec (POM) sheet structure — the points of measure, base size, grading notes (increment per size) and tolerances per POM. Fill in your details below.

Trend & Colour Forecast

Plan collections around trends — a trend direction (themes, colour palette, key categories, fabric and details) with India context (festive, regional, occasion wear) and a caution to validate with sales data. Fill in your details below.

Structure a balanced product range — a range plan by category (options, price band, role as hero/core/fashion/value), a balance check (category, price, colour) and buy depth by role. Fill in your details below.

Get clear, structured fit comments for sample corrections — per area the issue, correction and revised measurement, a priority (critical vs minor) and what to submit in the next sample. Fill in your details below.

Bill of Materials Builder

Get a complete bill of materials for a style — every component (fabric, lining, trims, labels, packing) with description, consumption, unit and a supplier note. Fill in your details below.

CAD & Digitisation Guide

Adopt CAD for pattern making, grading and markers — the uses, the benefits (speed, accuracy, fabric saving) and a selection and rollout plan (software options, training, migration). Fill in your details below.

Apparel Export Documentation Kit

Get your export paperwork right — a document checklist (commercial invoice, packing list, shipping bill, BL or AWB, certificate of origin, GSP or FTA certificate, LUT or IGST, inspection and test reports), the order-to-realisation flow and an Incoterm responsibilities note. Fill in your details below.

Export Setup & Registrations Guide

Start exporting with the right registrations — IEC from DGFT, RCMC from AEPC or the relevant council, AD code with your bank and LUT for GST, with a council note and getting-started steps in order. Fill in your details below.

Export Costing & Pricing

Price your exports properly — an export cost sheet (ex-factory cost, inland freight, port and customs, ocean or air freight, insurance, margin), price by Incoterm (FOB, CIF) and incentive offsets (RoDTEP, RoSCTL, drawback). Fill in your details below.

Meet what your export buyer and market demand — each requirement (REACH, CPSIA, Prop 65, social audit like SEDEX/BSCI/WRAP, restricted substances) with what it applies to and means, the documentation and how to prepare. Fill in your details below.

Claim the export incentives you are entitled to — each applicable scheme (RoSCTL, RoDTEP, Duty Drawback, EPCG, Advance Authorisation) with the benefit, eligibility and how to claim, plus documentation. Rates change; confirm on DGFT. Fill in your details below.

Proforma Invoice Generator

Generate a professional proforma invoice — seller and buyer, goods (style, HSN, quantity, unit price, amount), Incoterm and port, payment terms, validity and a bank-details note. Fill in your details below.

Export Sales Contract

Get a solid export sales contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering goods and specs, price and Incoterm, payment (LC or TT), delivery and shipment, inspection and AQL, quality and claims, force majeure and governing law and arbitration, plus schedules. Have an export or legal expert review. Fill in your details below.

Letter of Credit (LC) Guide

Handle export LCs without discrepancies — the basics (types, parties, key terms, expiry and latest shipment), how to prepare documents to match the LC exactly, common discrepancies to avoid and the process (advising, shipment, negotiation, realisation). Fill in your details below.

Shipment Coordination Planner
